

Goat Policy

INQUIRING:

Fill out the contact form on our website or Text/call using the number on our website.

PRICES:

- ✓ Bucks - \$150.00 and up
- ✓ Does - \$300.00 and up
- ✓ Prices vary by conformation, bloodline and color

PAYMENT:

- ✓ We accept PayPal, cash, money orders and cashier's check for deposits or payments. **If you pay using PayPal, we will not pay the fee.** You need send enough to cover the fee.
- ✓ WE DO NOT TAKE PERSONAL CHECKS

DEPOSITS:

- Goats can be sold at any time if there are no deposits on them. If a goat is put on hold or reserved, it will no longer be for sale.
- Deposit payment must be received for us to consider the goat on hold or reserved.
- To Reserve a goat, you will need to put at least 50% down for a deposit fee for each goat.
- If you back out of a sale we will reimburse you deposit.
- If we ever cancel a sale for any reason the deposit payment will be refunded.
- If something happens to your goat while on hold, your deposit payment can be refunded or you can apply the payment to another goat of your choice, as one becomes available.

REFUNDS:

- ❖ If your goat gets sick within the first week of taking it home, you may bring it back and we will refund or allow you to pick another goat, if we have any available.
- ❖ If your goat dies within the first week of taking it home, we will refund you money or you can forward to a hold on another goat, if available.

PICK UP:

- Goats are to be picked up at our place. Most of our full grown goats will fit in a large dog carrier. If you buy a baby they all can fit in a small dog carrier. Of course, in buying multiple goats would require a trailer or tote in the bed of a truck.
- We will on rare occasion be able to meet you halfway or somewhere within a reasonable distance for us within KS or MO. The goat must have a deposit placed on it FIRST and the remaining balance, plus mileage will be charged at pickup. There are also haulers that we can put you in touch with as well to transport.
